IB DP Admissions Policy

Mission Statement: American Youth Academy is committed to providing a rigorous and inclusive International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP) that fosters academic excellence, intercultural understanding, and personal growth.

Admissions Philosophy

We believe that the IB DP is suitable for students who are motivated, curious, and committed to academic excellence. Our admissions process aims to identify students who will thrive in this challenging and rewarding program.

Eligibility Criteria:

1 - Attitude and commitment: Curious and motivated students who enjoy studying a challenging curriculum.

2 - Grades: Preference will be given to highly motivated students who achieve a minimum GPA of 3.50 / 4.00. However, we recognize that grades may not reflect ability.

3 - Classes: Grades of 'B' or better in Algebra 2, English 2, Chemistry and AP World History / World History.

- 4. English Proficiency: Students must demonstrate proficiency in English
- 4 PSAT Scores: A review of achievement scores on the latest PSAT NMSQT test.
- 5 IBDP faculty review and approval

Admissions Process

1. Application: Students submit an application, which includes teacher recommendations and a personal statement.

2. Review: The IB DP Faculty and Coordinator review applications, considering all eligibility criteria

4. Decision: Students and parents are notified of their acceptance or denial via email

Appeals Process: Students may appeal the admissions decision by submitting a written appeal to the IB DP Admissions Committee.
